3 Last Day for Dispositive Motion Hearing¹. 10:00 a.m. on March 29, 2011
4 Final Pretrial Conference. 2:00 p.m. on April 26, 2011
5 Trial 9:30 a.m. on May 9, 2011

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall comply with the Standing Order for Civil
7 Practice in Cases Assigned for All Purposes to Magistrate Judge Paul S. Grewal (Dec. 2010), a copy
8 of which is available from the Clerk of the Court,² with regard to the timing and content of the Joint
9 Pretrial Statement, and all other pretrial submissions.
