

This case was tried by the Court sitting without a jury on April 29,
April 30, and May 2, 2003. Based upon the Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law
adopted by the Court, and having considered all of the evidence and argument presented
at trial by the parties and in the written closing arguments, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED,
ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that plaintiff Entrepreneur Media, Inc. be awarded
Judgment and a permanent injunction in this action against defendant Scott Smith dba
EntrepreneurPR as follows:

- 1. Defendant Scott Smith dba EntrepreneurPR, and his officers, agents, servants, employees, and attorneys, and all persons in active concert or participation with them, must immediately cease, and are permanently enjoined from, using the marks ENTREPRENEUR, ENTREPRENEURPR, ENTREPRENEUR ILLUSTRATED, and/or ENTREPRENEURPR.COM, or any other mark, trade name, or domain name that is a colorable imitation thereof or likely to cause confusion therewith, in commerce or in connection with the sale, offering for sale, distribution, and/or advertising of (1) paper goods and printed matter, and/or (2) advertising and business services, including online services. This permanent injunction specifically includes, but is not limited to, the "public relations" activities that Scott Smith dba EntrepreneurPR has previously provided under the marks referenced above.
- 2. Defendant Scott Smith dba EntrepreneurPR, and his officers, agents, servants, employees, and attorneys, and all persons in active concert or participation with them, are hereby ordered to immediately surrender to Entrepreneur Media, Inc. all advertising, publications, goods, labels, signage, packages, and any other materials that contain the marks ENTREPRENEUR, ENTREPRENEURPR, ENTREPRENEUR ILLUSTRATED, and/or ENTREPRENEURPR.COM, or any other mark that is a colorable imitation thereof or likely to cause confusion therewith.
- 3. Plaintiff Entrepreneur Media, Inc. is awarded damages in the amount of \$669,656, which includes damages of \$12,500 incurred after February 11, 2002.
 - 4. Because this is an exceptional case, in that defendant Scott Smith


