
On September 28, 2011, the parties filed a joint case management statement informing the Court that the parties "have reached a written settlement of both related cases. The settlement agreement has been signed by all parties and provides for dismissal of both related actions upon

1 completion of closing conditions. The parties anticipate that stipulations for dismissal will be
2 submitted to the Court within no more than two weeks.” ECF No. 28.

3 The Court filed an Order on September 30, 2011 continuing the case management
4 conference set for October 5, 2011 to October 19, 2011, at 2:00 p.m. in the related case of
5 Angiologix Inc. v. Merchant, 11-CV-00434. ECF No. 33. To clarify, the September 30 Order
6 applies to both related cases. Therefore, the case management conference for Everist Genomix,
7 Inc. v. Merchant, 11-CV-00437 set for October 5, 2011 is also continued to October 19, 2011, at
8 2:00 p.m. If the parties for both related cases file their stipulations of dismissal by 5:00 p.m. PST,
9 on Friday, October 14, 2011, the Court will vacate the case management conference. Otherwise,
10 all parties will be expected to attend the October 19, 2011 case management conference.
