ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR PARTIES TO FILE EITHER A “CONSENT TO PROCEED BEFORE A UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE,” OR ELSE A “DECLINATION TO PROCEED BEFORE A UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE AND REQUEST FOR REASSIGNMENT”

On March 21, 2011, Defendants filed a motion to dismiss this action, which has been assigned to a magistrate judge. As a result, each party was required either to file written consent to the jurisdiction of the magistrate judge or to request reassignment to a district judge, no later than March 28, 2011.¹ Defendants have consented to proceed before a magistrate judge. Plaintiff has neither consented nor requested reassignment. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no later than April 7, 2011, Plaintiff shall file either a “Consent to Proceed Before a United States Magistrate Judge,” or else a “Declination to Proceed Before a United States Magistrate Judge and Request for Reassignment.” Both forms are available from the clerk of the court or from the Forms (Civil) section of the court’s website at
