

Having reviewed the parties' Joint Case Management Statement (see Docket Item No. 117), the court finds that a Case Management Conference is unnecessary at this time. However, as previously ordered, any disputes with respect to discovery or disclosure, including any motions to compel same, are referred to the assigned Magistrate Judge. See Docket Item No. 64. Any request to stay disclosures or to stay discovery may be presented to this court through a motion for administrative relief under Civil Local Rule 7-11.
