On April 9, 2013, the parties appeared for a Case Management Conference. Based on the parties' Joint Case Management Statements (Case No. 11-1208, Dkt. No. 98, Case No. 11-1210, Dkt. No. 101), as modified by the discussion held at the Conference, the court orders as follows:

1 The court adopts the parties' statement of facts and legal issues as set forth in the Joint Case
2 Management Statements. The presumptive limits on discovery set forth in the Federal Rules of
3 Civil Procedure shall apply.

4 The following schedule shall apply to these cases:


- 5 Fact Discovery Cutoff July 1, 2013
- 6 Designation of Experts with Reports August 1, 2013
- 7 Designation of Rebuttal Experts with Reports August 29, 2013
- 8 Expert Discovery Cutoff September 23, 2013
- 9 Last Day for Hearings on Dispositive &
10 *Daubert* Motions November 11, 2013¹ at 10:00 a.m.
- 11 Final Pretrial Conference February 4, 2014 at 1:30 p.m.

12 In the event discovery disputes arise, the parties shall comply with this court's "Standing
13 Order re: Civil Discovery Disputes," which sets forth the applicable requirements and procedures
14 for filing Discovery Dispute Joint Reports rather than noticed discovery motions.² Parties seeking
15 to compel fact discovery must file a Joint Report no later than seven days after the Fact Discovery
16 Cutoff, and parties seeking to compel expert discovery must file a Joint Report no later than seven
17 days after the Expert Discovery Cutoff. Civ. L. R. 37-3.

18 At the Final Pretrial Conference, the parties shall be prepared to discuss dates for trial.
19 Additionally, the parties shall comply with the undersigned's Standing Order re: Pretrial Preparation
20 with regard to the timing and content of the Joint Pretrial Statement, and other pretrial submissions.
