1 I, Mia Mazza, declare as follows:

2 1. I am a partner in the law firm of Morrison & Foerster LLP, counsel for Apple Inc.
3 (“Apple”). I am licensed to practice law in the State of California. Unless otherwise indicated, I
4 have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein or understand them to be true from
5 members of my litigation team. I make this Declaration in support of Apple’s Opposition to
6 Samsung’s Renewed Motion to Compel Discovery Relating to Mac OS 10.

7 2. The parties held their first in-person lead trial counsel meeting on January 5, 2012,
8 to discuss the parties’ respective positions on numerous outstanding discovery issues and
9 determine whether those issues could be resolved without court intervention. The night before
10 the meeting, Apple advised Samsung by letter that technicians were working on resolving the
11 brightness window problem on the computer made available to Samsung. That letter is attached
12 to the Declaration of Jason R. Bartlett in Support of Apple’s Opposition to Samsung’s Motion to
13 Enforce Various Court Orders filed herewith as Exhibit B.

14 3. Samsung did not raise the Mac OS 10.0 computer issue the next day during the
15 lead counsel conference. Nor did Samsung communicate further with Apple on this issue before
16 filing its motion to compel on January 11, 2012.
