16 On August 11, 2011, Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, filed a civil rights 17 complaint pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On October 4, 2011, Plaintiff filed a letter requesting 18 that his court action not continue. The Court construes Plaintiff's letter as a notice of voluntary 19 dismissal pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1). Plaintiff may voluntarily dismiss 20 his complaint without order of this Court if he files his notice before Defendants serve an answer 21 or motion for summary judgment. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(i); American Soccer Co. v. Score 22 First Enters., 187 F. 3d 1108, 1110 (9th Cir. 1999) (noting that a plaintiff has an "absolute right" 23 to dismiss his action voluntarily before defendant serves an answer or a motion for summary 24 judgment). Accordingly, this action is DISMISSED without prejudice. The Clerk shall close the 25 file.
