1 Pursuant to Civil Local Rule 6-2, 7-12, and related rules, Plaintiff Guzik Technical
2 Enterprises, Inc. (“GTE” or “Plaintiff”) and Western Digital Corporation, Western Digital
3 Technologies, Inc., Western Digital (Fremont), LLC, Western Digital (Thailand) Company
4 Limited, and Western Digital (Malaysia) Sdn. Bhd. (collectively referred to herein as “Western
5 Digital Defendants”), hereby stipulate through their respective counsel of record as follows:

6 WHEREAS, on August 1, 2011, GTE filed its Complaint against the Western Digital
7 Defendants;

8 WHEREAS, on August 1, 2011, the Court issued an Order Setting Initial Case
9 Management Conference and ADR Deadlines (ECF No. 8) which, among other provisions, set an
10 Initial Case Management Conference in the above-specified action on October 18, 2011, and
11 specified related deadlines leading up to that conference;

12 WHEREAS, the Court ordered, pursuant to the Parties’ stipulation, that The Western
13 Digital Defendants would have until September 26, 2011 to file a response to the complaint and
14 that the Initial Case Management Conference be continued from October 18, 2011 to November
15 15, 2011, in Courtroom 5, 4th Floor, San Jose Courthouse, at 2:00 p.m., and that all other dates
16 would be continued;

17 WHEREAS the Court ordered, pursuant to the Parties’ stipulation, that GTE would have
18 until November 16, 2011 to file a response to Western Digital’s Counterclaims and that the Initial
19 Case Management Conference be continued from November 15, 2011 to December 13, 2011, in
20 Courtroom 5, 4th Floor, San Jose Courthouse, at 2:00 p.m., and that all other dates would be
21 continued;

22 WHEREAS trial counsel for GTE has just been ordered to prepare a brief in another case
23 under an abbreviated briefing schedule that creates an unforeseen conflict with the Initial Case
24 Management Conference. Trial counsel will receive an opposition brief on the morning of
25 December 13, 2011, and is required to submit a reply brief by 9:00 AM EST on December 14,
26 2011. Trial counsel therefore is required to prepare its brief on December 13, 2011, and is unable
27 to attend the Initial Case Management Conference scheduled for December 13, 2011;
