

arbitration award entered in London. Inzajat sought an order confirming the award, which this court
granted on January 20, 2012. Dkt. No. 23. Inzajat now seeks entry of judgment, and requests that the
court hear the motion on shortened time. Dkt. No. 37. Defendant Hamid Najafi, who was served
with a summons and the petition to confirm the arbitration award on August 25, 2011, has only
recently appeared in this action and seeks a stay of enforcement of judgment. He has not opposed
the motion to shorten time.

Having considered plaintiff's request, the court does not find good cause to hear the motion
on shortened time, so plaintiff's request is DENIED. The request for entry of judgment as well as
defendant's request for a stay shall be heard on March 20, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. Briefing on the
pending motions shall proceed in accordance with Civil Local Rule 7-3.
