Plaintiff has filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss the matter, 20 indicating that he is refiling the claims in a federal habeas action. (Docket No. 54.) A plaintiff has the absolute right to dismiss his or her action by filing a notice of 21 dismissal "at any time before service by the adverse party of an answer or of a motion for 22 summary judgment." Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(i). Said dismissal may be with or without 23 prejudice, but unless plaintiff's notice of dismissal states otherwise, it is deemed to be 24 25 "without prejudice." See Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1); Humphreys v. United States, 272 F.2d 26 411, 412 (9th Cir. 1959).
