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1 The Parties to the above-captioned action, by and through their undersigned counsel,
2 hereby stipulate that:

3 WHEREAS, on October 26, 2011, the first of three securities fraud class actions was
4 filed against OmniVision Technologies, Inc., Anson Chan and Aurelio “Ray” Cisneros
5 (collectively “Defendants”);

6 WHEREAS, on February 21, 2012, the Court entered an order appointing the
7 Institutional Investors Group as lead plaintiff, approving the Institutional Investors Group’s
8 choice of counsel and consolidating the three securities fraud class actions under the caption In
9 re OmniVision Technologies, Inc. Securities Litigation;

10 WHEREAS, on April 23, 2012, the Institutional Investors Group filed Lead Plaintiff’s
11 Consolidated Class Action Complaint;

12 WHEREAS, on June 25, 2012, Defendants filed a motion to dismiss Lead Plaintiff’s
13 Consolidated Class Action Complaint;

14 WHEREAS, on October 16, 2012, a Clerk’s Notice was entered scheduling a Case
15 Management Conference for December 14, 2012 and requiring a Joint Case Management
16 Statement be filed no later than December 7, 2012;

17 WHEREAS, on October 26, 2012, the Court heard argument on Defendants’ motion to
18 dismiss Lead Plaintiff’s Consolidated Class Action Complaint;

19 WHEREAS, pursuant to the Private Securities Litigation Reform Act, discovery in this
20 action is currently stayed;

21 WHEREAS, the parties agree that a Case Management Conference will be more
22 productive if held after resolution of the pending motion to dismiss; and

23 WHEREAS the parties respectfully submit that in the interest of conserving judicial
24 resources, the Case Management Conference should be vacated pending a ruling on Defendants’
25 Motion to Dismiss.

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ORDER

Pursuant to the STIPULATION OF THE PARTIES, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED

1. The Deadlines associated with the Clerk's Notice of October 16, 2012 are vacated; and
