Related deadlines are adjusted accordingly.



In accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 636, the magistrate judges of this district are designated to conduct any and all proceedings in a civil case (including trial and entry of judgment), upon consent of the parties. An appeal from a judgment entered by a magistrate judge may be taken directly to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the same manner as an appeal from any other judgment of a district judge.

Parties have the right to decline to proceed before a magistrate and to request reassignment to a district judge without adverse substantive consequences. Fed. R. Civ. P. 73(b)(2). The Aguileras shall, **no later than January 25, 2012**, inform the court whether they consent to magistrate judge jurisdiction or whether they request reassignment to a district judge by filing either (1) a Consent to Proceed Before a United States Magistrate Judge or (2) a Declination to Proceed Before a Magistrate Judge and Request for Reassignment to a United States District Judge.
