Plaintiff, a California state prisoner currently incarcerated at Salinas Valley State Prison, filed a pro se civil rights complaint pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff’s motion to proceed in forma pauperis is GRANTED. The total filing fee that will ultimately be due is \$350.00. In view of plaintiff’s lack of income and zero account balance over the last six months, no initial partial filing fee is due.
