should apply to preclude Plaintiffs' ECJ claims. The Court hereby GRANTS Defendant's Motion for Leave. The Court's July 12, 2013 Order, ECF No. 125, is VACATED.

Plaintiffs indicated that they also intend to file a Motion for Leave to File a Motion for Reconsideration of certain aspects of the Court's July 12, 2013 Order. Plaintiffs shall file their Motion for Leave by July 31, 2013. Defendant shall file its response by August 7, 2013. Plaintiffs Motion for Leave and Defendant's response shall be limited to 7 pages each. No Reply shall be permitted. After Plaintiffs' Motion for Leave has been decided, the Court will set a hearing date for Defendant's Motion for Reconsideration, or, if Plaintiffs are granted leave, both parties' Motions for Reconsideration. The parties shall then stipulate to a briefing schedule.

With respect to the Case Management Conference, discovery and initial disclosures remain stayed. The Court also declines to set a case schedule. A further Case Management Conference will take place on October 30, 2013 at 2:00 p.m.
