No. 102). Admin. Mot., Dkt. No. 110. The court agrees with Realtek that a bond is 23 required under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure ("Rule") 65(c). Defendants do not oppose the 24 appropriateness of a bond, but respond that they "are currently unable to determine those 'costs and 25 damages sustained by any party found to have been wrongfully enjoined or restrained." Response 26 2, Dkt. No. 114 (quoting Rule 65(c)). 27 The court GRANTS Realtek's administrative motion. Because defendants do not propose 28
