The court appreciates the work the parties put into the Amended Joint Proposed Voir Dire questions and the court anticipates asking most, if not all, of the questions proposed. After the questionnaires are completed, copies will be made available to the parties for use during the selection process commencing at 1:30 p.m. The written hardship claims and any answers which raise an obvious basis for a cause challenge will be reviewed and in most cases ruled on based upon the answers given so that most of the prospective jurors who are brought into the courtroom will be eligible to serve.
