The presumptive limits on discovery set forth in the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure shall apply to this case and any previously conducted discovery will count against those limits. The court sets the following schedule:

Expert Designation	October 7, 2013
Discovery Cut-off	November 11, 2013
Dispositive Motion Cut-off	December 20, 2013
Pretrial Conference	February 27, 2013
Trial	March 17, 2014

1 Cardinale may depose Knapp, in any and all of his capacities, during a single deposition.
2 Judge Lloyd is handling discovery disputes, and if any discovery disputes arise, the parties shall
3 comply with Judge Lloyd's "Standing Order re: Civil Discovery Disputes," which sets forth the
4 applicable requirements and procedures for filing Discovery Dispute Joint Reports rather than
5 noticed discovery motions. The court notes that Judge Lloyd's standing orders require in person
6 meet and confers if phone conversations fail to resolve an issue. Parties seeking to compel fact
7 discovery must file a Joint Report no later than seven days after the Fact Discovery Cutoff, and
8 parties seeking to compel expert discovery must file a Joint Report no later than seven days after the
9 Expert Discovery Cutoff. Civ. L. R. 37-3.
