**OMNIBUS ORDER RE: MOTIONS TO SEAL** 

(Re: Docket Nos. 464, 471, 476, 479, 484, 486, 487, 490, 492, 504)

Before the court are 10 administrative motions to seal 33 documents. "Historically, courts have recognized a 'general right to inspect and copy public records and documents, including judicial records and documents."<sup>1</sup> Accordingly, when considering a sealing request, "a 'strong presumption in favor of access' is the starting point."<sup>2</sup> Parties seeking to seal judicial records relating to dispositive motions bear the burden of overcoming the presumption with "compelling reasons" that outweigh the general history of access and the public policies favoring disclosure.<sup>3</sup> <sup>1</sup> *Kamakana v. However, "while protecting the public's interest in access to the courts, we must remain 1 2 mindful of the parties' right to access those same courts upon terms which will not unduly harm their competitive interest."<sup>4</sup> Records attached to nondispositive motions therefore are not subject 3 to the strong presumption of access.<sup>5</sup> Because the documents attached to nondispositive motions 4 5 "are often unrelated, or only tangentially related, to the underlying cause of action," parties moving to seal must meet the lower "good cause" standard of Rule 26(c).<sup>6</sup> As with dispositive motions, the 6 standard applicable to nondispositive motions requires a "particularized showing"<sup>7</sup> that "specific 7 prejudice or harm will result" if the information is disclosed.<sup>8</sup> "Broad allegations of harm, 8 9 unsubstantiated by specific examples of articulated reasoning" will not suffice.<sup>9</sup> A protective order sealing the documents during discovery may reflect the court's previous determination that good 10 cause exists to keep the documents sealed,<sup>10</sup> but a blanket protective order that allows the parties to 11 designate confidential documents does not provide sufficient judicial scrutiny to determine whether 12 each particular document should remain sealed.<sup>11</sup> 13 In addition to making particularized showings of good cause, parties moving to seal 14 15 documents must comply with the procedures established by Civ. L.R. 79-5. Pursuant to Civ. L.R. 79-5(b), a sealing order is appropriate only upon a request that establishes the document 16 17 is "sealable," or "privileged or protectable as a trade secret or otherwise entitled to protection under the law." Case No.: 5:13-cv-01081-PSG OMNIBUS ORDER RE: MOTIONS TO SEAL must conform with Civil L.R. 79-5(d)."<sup>12</sup> "Within 4 days of the filing of the Administrative
Motion to File Under Seal, the Designating Party must file a declaration as required by subsection
79-5(d)(1)(A) establishing that all of the designated material is sealable."<sup>13</sup>

With these standards in mind, the court rules on the instant motions as follows:
