> If service of the summons and complaint is not made upon a defendant within 120 days after the filing of the complaint, the court, upon motion or on its own initiative after notice to the plaintiff, shall dismiss the action without prejudice as to that defendant or direct that service be effected within a specified time; provided that if the plaintiff shows good cause for the failure, the court shall extend the time for service for an appropriate period.

The 120-day period for service provided by Rule 4(m) expired on August 22, 2013.

Accordingly, the court issues the instant Order to Show Cause ("OSC") requiring that Plaintiff, no later than October 14, 2013, either: (1) file documents to show proof of service of the Summons and
