Rather than file a motion for summary judgment, answer, or motion for an extension of time, defendant Martin has not further communicated with the court. Accordingly, defendant Martin **ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE** why an entry of default should not be made against him. Defendant Martin must file a written response to this Order to Show Cause within **thirty** (30) days of the filing date of this order. Failure to file a timely written response may be deemed an admission that no good cause exists for defendant's failure to follow the court's September 24, 2014 order, and an entry of default may issue without further proceedings.
