ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On August 13, 2013, Petitioner, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, filed a petition for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254, and an In Forma Pauperis (“IFP”) Application. On the same day, the Clerk of the Court sent a notice to Petitioner informing him that the IFP Application was incomplete and that he needed to file a complete IFP Application within twenty-eight days. (Docket No. 3.) On October 18, 2013, the Court granted Petitioner an extension of time until November 18, 2013, to either file a complete IFP Application or pay the full filing fee. (Docket No. 6.) The deadline has since passed, and Petitioner has failed to respond. Accordingly, this case is **DISMISSED** without prejudice for failure to pay the filing fee.
