17	On October 7, 2013, petitioner, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, filed a federal writ of	
18	habeas corpus. That same day, the court sent a notification to petitioner, informing him that he	
19	did not pay the filing fee, nor did he file a completed application to proceed in forma pauperis	
20	("IFP"). The court provided petitioner with a blank IFP application, along with a return	
21	envelope, and a notification that the case would be dismissed if petitioner failed to pay the fee, or	
22	file a completed application with supporting documentation within twenty-eight days. To date,	
23	petitioner has not paid the filing fee or filed a complete IFP application. As more than twenty-	
	eight days have passed since petitioner was instructed to do so, this case is DISMISSED without	
24	prejudice. The Clerk shall terminate all pending motions and close the case.
