On October 7, 2013, petitioner, a state prisoner proceeding *pro se*, filed a federal writ of habeas corpus. That same day, the court sent a notification to petitioner, informing him that he did not pay the filing fee, nor did he file a completed application to proceed in forma pauperis (“IFP”). The court provided petitioner with a blank IFP application, along with a return envelope, and a notification that the case would be dismissed if petitioner failed to pay the fee, or file a completed application with supporting documentation within twenty-eight days. To date, petitioner has not paid the filing fee or filed a complete IFP application. As more than twenty-eight days have passed since petitioner was instructed to do so, this case is DISMISSED without prejudice. The Clerk shall terminate all pending motions and close the case.
