

Jim Erickson and Erickson Productions, Inc. (collectively, Erickson) move for an order in 17 18 aid of enforcement of judgment, namely Kast's physical address. This court retains jurisdiction to 19 entertain that motion. Lara v. Sec'y of the Interior, 820 F.2d 1535, 1543 (9th Cir. 1987). Courts 20 generally enforce judgments in accordance with the procedure of the state in which it sits. Fed. R. Civ. P. 69(a). Erickson correctly notes that if they seek a judgment debtor exam, notice must be 21 personally served on Kast. Cal. Code Civ. Proc. §708.110(d). Erickson's request therefore is 22 23 GRANTED. Within 10 days from the date of this order, Kast shall provide Erickson's counsel with his physical address where he may be personally served. Although this court is unpersuaded 24 25 by Kast's stated need for a protective order, Kast's address shall be disclosed on an Attorney's Eyes Only basis. 26
