SCHEDULING NOTES AND STANDING ORDER

Criminal Law and Motion calendar is conducted on Mondays at 2:00 p.m. for defendants in custody and 2:30 p.m. for defendants not in custody. Case Management Conferences and Pretrial Conferences are conducted on Wednesdays at 2:00 p.m. Civil Motion calendar is conducted on Thursdays at 2:00 p.m. Order of call is determined by the Court. Parties need not reserve a hearing date for civil motions; however, parties must check the legal newspapers or the Court's website at www.cand.uscourts.gov for unavailable dates.

6 **Discovery disputes** will be referred to a Magistrate Judge. After the 7 parties have met and conferred, the parties shall prepare a joint letter of not more than 8 pages explaining the dispute. Up to 12 8 pages of attachments may be added. The joint letter must be electronically filed under the Civil Events category of "Motions and 9 Related Filings >Motions-- General > Discovery Letter Brief." The Magistrate Judge to whom the matter is assigned will advise the 10 parties of how that Judge intends to proceed. The Magistrate Judge 11 may issue a ruling, order more formal briefing, or set a telephone conference or a hearing. After a Magistrate Judge has been assigned, 12 all further discovery matters shall be filed pursuant to that Judge's procedures. 13

Motions for Summary Judgment: Absent permission from the Court, all 14 case-dispositive motions in a case will be briefed and heard together, 15 on the case-dispositive motion hearing cut-off date, or on an earlier available date agreed to by the parties. Multiple parties should file 16 joint briefs if possible. If Plaintiffs wish to file a motion for summary judgment, they shall do so 6 weeks before the cut-off date. 17 If Defendants wish to file a cross-motion as well as an opposition to the motion, any cross-motion shall be contained within the opposition 18 to the motion, which may contain up to 25 pages in total, and shall 19 be filed 14 days after the filing of the motion. The reply to the motion shall include the opposition to any cross-motion, may contain 20 up to 15 pages in total, and shall be filed 7 days after the filing of the opposition. A reply to any cross-motion may contain up to 15 21 pages, and shall be filed 7 days after the filing of the opposition. 22 If Plaintiffs do not file a motion for summary judgment, Defendants may file one 5 weeks before the case-dispositive motion hearing cut-23 off date and the schedule in Local Rule 7-3 shall apply. Courtesv copies of multi-page exhibits for chambers should be clearly marked 24 with tabbed dividers.
