Number of likes of this URL

The number of shares of this URL (this includes copy/pasting a link back to Facebook)

The number of likes and comments on stories on Facebook about this URL

The number of inbox messages containing this URL as an attachment.

So in theory a user could share a URL over and over again or keep sending inbox messages to boost the count. We've accepted this; but I actually like the model of a single user is either connected or not this URL. So one user can increment the count at most once. Lets go this route.
