

1	protocols, and Facebook need only to deposit updated code on the existing review computer.
2	Facebook has ample resources to do so, and Plaintiff have no other means of accessing this
3	information, and thus the benefit of this discovery outweighs the relative burden or expense,
4	pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(b)(2).
5	Accordingly, the Court ORDERS as follows:
6	1. Facebook shall produce all relevant source code from January 2013 to May 18,
7	2016.
8	2. The source code shall be deposited on the existing review computer utilized by the
9	parties within two weeks of this Order.
