**[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING
MOTION FOR WITHDRAWAL OF
DAVID SHADPOUR AND DISMISSAL OF
HIS CLAIMS WITHOUT PREJUDICE**

Having considered all the papers and pleadings on file, and for good cause appearing, this Court hereby **GRANTS** Plaintiffs' motion to withdraw David Shadpour as a putative class representative and to dismiss his claims without prejudice. Such dismissal will not result in plain legal prejudice to Defendant if it is not conditioned upon David Shadpour's willingness to sit for a deposition and provide outstanding discovery.

**ACCORDINGLY, FOR GOOD CAUSE SHOWN, THE COURT HEREBY
ORDERS THAT:** David Shadpour is dismissed from this action, without the condition that he sit for a deposition or provide outstanding discovery, and without prejudice to his rights as an absent member of the putative class.
