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11 Plaintiffs filed this action on January 23, 2014, and Defendants, or some of them, were  
12 served on February 7, 2014. Pursuant to F.R.C.P. 12(a)(1)(A)(i), Defendants were required to  
13 respond to the complaint on or before February 28, 2014. The parties stipulated on March 4, 2014,  
14 however, to extend Defendants’ time to answer the Complaint to April 4, 2014, and an Order to  
15 that effect was entered by this Court on March 6, 2014. The parties wish now to stipulate to extend  
16 that date once again by 35 days to May 9, 2014. Good cause exists for this extension to allow the  
17 parties to discuss potential settlement of the claims in the Complaint. There has been one  
18 extension of time for Defendants to answer the Complaint, but because the Complaint was  
19 recently filed, there is no prejudice to either party in extending the time for Defendants to answer.
