16	Plaintiffs have responded that a fire destroyed the offices of Plaintiffs' counsel and that	
17	counsel have only recently been able to set up a temporary office and resume their work. Dkt. No.	
18	33. Plaintiffs ask the court to continue the status conference by sixty days "to allow for	
19	submission of a new motion seeking default judgment[.]"	
20	The court continues the status conference to April 26, 2016. The court shall vacate the	
21	status conference if Plaintiffs file a motion for default judgment by April 22, 2016.
