
**ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED
MOTION FOR ATTORNEY'S FEES**

(Re: Docket No. 46)

Before the court is a motion for attorney's fees by Plaintiff Juan Carlos Martinez.¹ Because Martinez prevailed on his claims under the Fair Labor and Standards Act at trial,² he argues that the FLSA entitles him to recover reasonable attorney's fees and costs of litigation.³ Defendants Trung Q. Le and Letech Manufacturing, Inc. have not opposed the motion. Pursuant to Civ. L.R. 7-1(b), the court finds the motion suitable for disposition without oral argument and vacates the hearing currently scheduled for tomorrow. The motion is GRANTED as unopposed.
