ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED **MOTION FOR ATTORNEY'S FEES**

Before the court is a motion for attorney's fees by Plaintiff Juan Carlos Martinez.¹ Because Martinez prevailed on his claims under the Fair Labor and Standards Act at trial,² he argues that the FLSA entitles him to recover reasonable attorney's fees and costs of litigation.³ Defendants Trung Q.
