AMENDED ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR ATTORNEY'S FEES

(Re: Docket No. 46)

Before the court is a motion for attorney's fees by Plaintiff Juan Carlos Martinez.<sup>1</sup> Because Martinez prevailed on his claims under the Fair Labor and Standards Act at trial,<sup>2</sup> he argues that the FLSA entitles him to recover reasonable attorney's fees and costs of litigation.<sup>3</sup> Defendant Letech Manufacturing, Inc. has not opposed the motion.
