On August 14, 2014, defendant moved to dismiss plaintiff's complaint. Pursuant to Civil Local Rule 73-1, all parties were required to file, no later than September 16, 2014, either (1) a Consent to Proceed Before a United States Magistrate Judge or (2) a Declination to Proceed Before a Magistrate Judge and Request for Reassignment to a United States District Judge.
