**ORDER DISCHARGING ORDER TO
SHOW CAUSE**

On January 6, 2015, the court issued an order requiring Plaintiff Gregoria Amaya (“Plaintiff”) to show cause why this action should not be dismissed for failure to complete service by the deadline imposed by Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(m). See Docket Item No. 8. In order to prevent dismissal, the court required Plaintiff to either file a proof of service of process or explain why such service had not been accomplished.
