That 17 same day, the clerk notified plaintiff that he had not paid the filing fee, nor had he filed an 18 application to proceed in forma pauperis ("IFP"). (Docket No. 2.) Along with the deficiency 19 notice, plaintiff was provided with an IFP application and instructions for completing it. 20 Plaintiff was further cautioned that his failure to file a completed IFP application or pay the 21 filing fee within twenty-eight days would result in the dismissal of this action. More than 22 23 twenty-eight days have passed and plaintiff has not paid his filing fee or filed a completed IFP 24 application. Thus, the instant action is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
