ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On October 21, 2014, Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, filed a complaint pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff filed two In Forma Pauperis (“IFP”) Applications which were both deficient because neither included a Certificate of Funds in Prisoner’s Account completed and signed by an authorized prison official. (Docket Nos. 3 & 4.) On December 2, 2014, the Court granted Plaintiff an extension of twenty-eight days to file a complete IFP application and avoid dismissal of this action. (See Docket No. 6.) On January 20, 2015, after Plaintiff filed additional documents that were also insufficient, (see Docket No. 7), the Court granted Plaintiff a final extension of twenty-eight days to file a proper Certificate of Funds, *i.e.*, no later than February 17, 2015. (Docket No. 8.)


The deadline has since passed, and Plaintiff has neither paid the filing fee nor filed

1 the necessary documents to complete his IFP application. Accordingly, this case is
2 **DISMISSED** without prejudice for failure to pay the filing fee.

3 The Clerk shall terminate any pending motions and close the file.
