**ORDER DIRECTING PARTIES TO
FILE A JOINT STIPULATION OF
DISMISSAL**

On October 9, 2015, Plaintiff Fariba Rahimian Marnani filed a notice of settlement voluntarily dismissing, with prejudice, all of Plaintiff’s claims against Defendants Mezzetti Financial Services, Inc., Jose Mezzetti, Holmes & Uzo, LLP, and Leslie Anne Holmes (collectively, “Defendants”). ECF No. 40. However, Defendants have already filed answers in this case. ECF Nos. 19-21 (answers); 32-34 (amended answers). Thus, Plaintiff may only voluntarily dismiss without a Court order by filing “a stipulation of dismissal signed by all parties who have appeared.” Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A); see also Concha v. London, 62 F.3d 1493, 1506 (9th Cir. 1995). Accordingly, if the case is settled, the Court ORDERS the parties to file a joint stipulation of dismissal by October 13, 2015.

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IT IS SO ORDERED.
