ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO APPOINT GUARDIAN AD LITEM

Before the Court is Plaintiff Rafael Munoz's motion to appoint himself as guardian ad litem for Plaintiff J.M., a minor. ECF 111. Mr. Rafael Munoz is J.M.'s father and legal guardian, and declares that he has no interests adverse to J.M., and that the appointment is intended for this litigation only. See ECF 113. Having considered Plaintiff Munoz's submissions, the Court finds the matter appropriate for submission without a hearing and Mr. Rafael Munoz a suitable representative for J.M.'s interests in this action. Accordingly, the Court GRANTS the motion to appoint guardian ad litem for purposes of this action, and VACATES the hearing scheduled for this motion. Civ. L.R. 7-11(b).
