1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall present discovery disputes to the court
2 through an informal letter briefing process. The parties shall meet and confer and submit a joint
3 letter to the court, not to exceed three pages per side. The court shall set a hearing, if necessary, or
4 simply decide the matter on the papers.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall engage in private mediation within 90
6 days of the court's claim construction order.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the court shall hold a further case management
8 conference 15 after the court's claim construction order.
