Doc. 6

On August 12, 2015, Plaintiff filed an IFP application which is still deficient because he failed to provide items (3) and (4) described above. See supra at 1. Because Plaintiff indicated on the cover page of the document he provided that the support papers "should be there soon," (Docket No. 4 at 1), the Court granted Plaintiff an extension of time to October 19, 2015, in which to file a complete IFP application. (Docket No. 5.)

The deadline has since passed, and Plaintiff has neither paid the filing fee nor filed the necessary documents to complete his IFP application. Accordingly, this case is **DISMISSED** without prejudice for failure to pay the filing fee.

The Clerk shall terminate any pending motions and close the file.
