19 This matter came on regularly for hearing on August 2, 2018, at 9:00 a.m. in Courtroom 4
 20 of the United States District Court of the Northern District of California, located at 280 South 1st
 21 Street, San Jose, California, before the Honorable Edward J. Davila, with appearances by counsel
 22 as follows: B. James Fitzpatrick of Fitzpatrick & Swanston for Plaintiff Alvaro Sanchez and Jon

24 This matter having been fully argued and considered and proof having been made to the
 25 satisfaction of the Court, and the amount sought appearing to be fair and reasonable,

26 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

27 1. Class Counsel's request for an award of attorneys' fees in the amount of
 28 \$23,125.00 (25% of the Gross Settlement Amount) to be paid from the Settlement Fund pursuant

1 to Federal Rules of Civil Procedure Rule 23(h) is reasonable in light of the relevant factors and
2 comparison to the lodestar multiplier based upon the hours spent in prosecuting this case. The
3 request for an award of attorneys' fees in the amount of \$23,125.00 is GRANTED.

4 2. Class Counsel's request for an award of litigation cost reimbursement in the
5 amount of \$3,042.66, to be paid from the Settlement Fund pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil
6 Procedure Rule 23(h) is reasonable and the funds were necessarily incurred in the prosecution of
7 the case. The request for cost reimbursement in the amount of \$3,042.66 is GRANTED.

8 3. IT IS SO ORDERED.
