after service of appellant's brief. If the appellee has filed a cross-appeal, the brief of appellee shall 2 contain the issues and arguments pertinent to the cross-appeal, denominated as such, and the 3 response to the brief of the appellant.

The appellant may serve and file a reply brief not exceeding 15 pages in length within 14 days after service of appellee's brief, and if the appellee has filed a cross-appeal, the appellee may file and serve a reply brief not exceeding 15 pages in length to the response of the appellant to the issues presented in the cross-appeal within 14 days after service of the reply brief of the appellant.

Pursuant to B.L.R 8012-1, upon completion of the briefing, the assigned District Judge will set a date for oral argument, if needed; otherwise the matter will be deemed submitted for decision.
