

On November 27, 2015, Plaintiff, a state prisoner at San Quentin State Prison, filed a pro se letter which the Court construed as a civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. (Docket No. 1.)¹ The Clerk sent notice to Plaintiff that in order to proceed he must file a complaint on the Court’s form and file an application to proceed in forma paupers. (See Docket Nos. 2 & 3.) On December 7, 2015, in response to the Clerk’s notice, Plaintiff filed a document entitled “Unintended Filing Notice,” in which he states that the letter he sent was intended for Judge Thelton Henderson and that he was in the process of exhausting his administrative remedies before filing a civil complaint. (Docket No. 5.) On December 30, 2015, Plaintiff filed a second notice of unintended

1 filing. (Docket No. 8.) Plaintiff's filings indicate that he never intended to file a civil
2 action. Accordingly, the Court finds that the instant case was opened in error and directs
3 the Clerk to terminate any pending deadlines and administratively close the case.
