 - f. Any party seeking to exceed these limits must apply to this Court.
- (2) The Discovery and trial schedule are the following:
 - a. Non-Expert discovery cutoff: April 10, 2017
 - b. Expert Designations and Reports Due: May 7, 2017
 - c. Expert Discovery Cutoff: June 5, 2017
