DECLARATION OF WARREN METLITZKY

I, Warren Metlitzky, declare:

- 1. I am an Assistant United States Attorney in the Northern District of California.
- 2. This declaration is submitted in support of the United States' application for an order pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1782 concerning a request from an Estonian Court for information from Google, Inc. ("Google").
- 3. By correspondence dated January 21, 2015, I asked Google's counsel whether Google opposes entry of a proposed order that authorizes Google to provide the requested information directly to the Estonian Court, consistent with the process Google followed in a prior case. A true and correct copy of my January 21, 2015 letter to Google, which included a copy of a proposed order and the Estonian Court's request for information, is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 4. I spoke with Einat Clarke, counsel for Google, on the telephone during the week of February 2. She explained Google's legal position, *i.e.* that it contends that it is prohibited by federal statute from providing the requested information directly to the United States Attorney's Office, who in turn would provide it to the Estonian Court. However, Ms. Clarke further explained that Google is willing to provide the information, to the extent that it exists and is reasonably available, directly to the Estonian Court pursuant to a United States federal court subpoena for the information through the process identified in my January 21, 2015 letter.
- 5. By email dated February 18, 2015, Google explained which information it was able to provide to the Estonian Court, and which information was not readily accessible. Google also confirmed that prior to providing information to the Estonian court, it would provide to the United States Attorney's Office a redacted version (with personal information removed) of the declaration and documents to be sent to the Estonian Court. Attached hereto as Exhibit B is a true and correct copy of that February 18, 2015 email correspondence between Einat Clarke at Google and me.
- 6. The Estonian Court has agreed to accept the requested information directly from Google. Attached hereto as Exhibit C is a true and correct copy of February 20, 2015 email chain from Douglass Ross of the Office of International Judicial Assistance at the Department of Justice and Siiri Pajupuu,

the lawyer representing the Harju County Court in this matter. On March 26, 2015, I served Google via email with this application and supporting 7. papers, documents for which which Google agreed to accept service via email. On April 20, 2015, Google stated that it did not oppose entry of the proposed order in this case. Attached hereto as Exhibit D is a true and correct copy of an April 20, 2015 email from Einat Clarke to me.
