 24 breakdown of the attorney-client relationship has occurred which has made it impossible for Trinh

26 The parties are currently scheduled for a settlement conference before Magistrate Judge  
 27 Nathanael M. Cousins on July 26, 2016 at 9:30 a.m. (Dkt. No. 33).

1 Counsel for the parties met and conferred on July 18, 2016 and discussed a continuance of  
2 the settlement conference given the two pending motions before the Court. Robern does not  
3 oppose Shine Bathrooms, Inc.'s request for a continuance provided that Shine Bathrooms, Inc.  
4 reimburses Robern for any nonrefundable travel costs incurred in connection with the July 26,  
5 2016 settlement conference.

6 The parties agree that the settlement conference should be rescheduled as soon as practical  
7 once the Court has decided the Pending Motions.

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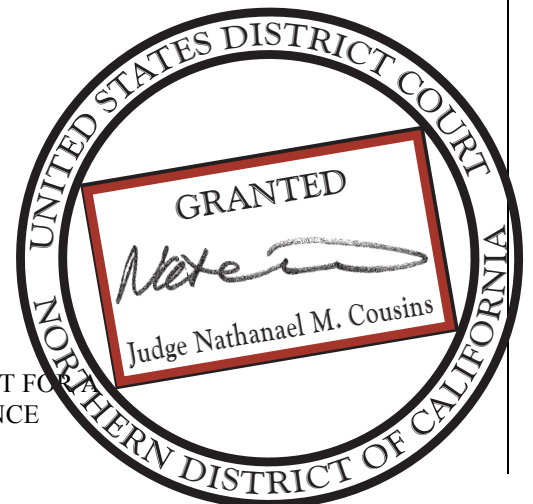
