20	plaintiff shows good cause for the failure, the court must extend the time for service for an appropriate period.	
21	The 90-day period for service provided by Rule 4(m) expired on June 27, 2016.	
22	Accordingly, the court issues the instant Order to Show Cause why Tidewater should not be	
23	dismissed without prejudice for lack of service. If Plaintiff does not, no later than August 19,	
24	2016 , either: (1) file documents to show proof of se	
25	Tidewater; or (2) explain in writing why service ha	-
