**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**


10 On November 10, 2016, the court issued an order requiring Plaintiff to dismiss or  
11 otherwise resolve her claims against Defendants Bank of America, N.A. and Tidewater Finance  
12 Company on or before December 16, 2016. Dkt. No. 88. The deadline to take such action has  
13 expired and Plaintiff has not complied.

14 Accordingly, Plaintiff and counsel for Plaintiff are ordered to appear before the Honorable  
15 Edward J. Davila on **January 19, 2017, at 11:00 a.m.** in Courtroom No. 4, 5th Floor, United  
16 States District Court, 280 S. First Street, San Jose, California, 95113, to show cause why the court  
17 should not impose any and all appropriate sanctions, including monetary sanctions or dismissal of  
18 this action, on Plaintiff and her counsel, or any of them, for willful disobedience of a court order.

19 Plaintiff and counsel for Plaintiff may file a response to this order demonstrating good  
20 cause why sanctions should not be imposed on or before **January 12, 2017.**
